



2018 Dry Creek Valley Pinot Noir

Our "11 Rows" small block production was sourced from Massoni Ranch in Healdsburg and produced a beautiful, light-bodied red wine. The cool Pacific air blanketed the vineyard in the evenings allowing a long hang time. Fermented on whole-grape clusters to increase tannin yield.

Harvested in October 2018, pressed and vinted at Koi Zen Cellars urban winery in San Diego. Our pilot and managing wine maker Bill Neail vinted free run juice from this harvest at his home winery to make a Rose. That Rose won Double Gold Best of Class at the 2019 California State fair in Sacramento.

Pinot Noir is believed to originate in the Burgundy region of France. It is the most popular light-bodied red wine in the world. Our 11 Rows Pinot Noir is light to medium-bodied, with high acidity, with enough tannin to give the wine structure.

Versatile food pairing due to its higher acidity and low tannin compared with other red wines. Pairs particularly well with duck, chicken, pork, and mushroom. Decant for 30 minutes and serve at 55 - 60F. You'll experience delicate cherry, raspberry fruit flavors accented by hints of clove and hibiscus. Enjoy the long, smooth finish, flower, and spice aromas.
